Report on Academic and Financial Plan	-Over the summer KES got a \$52,000 grant for Trauma Informed Education and Counseling. Training for the whole school, faculty and staff. -Supports students and families who have trauma from abuse, divorce, family problems, homelessness, death, etc. -Various upcoming workshops will be available to those interested. -King and Castle will continue with students so support will follow students. -Castle Foundation and Windward Community College also planning to follow Trauma Informed Education/Counseling. Basically will encompass from Makapu'u to Waihole. -Changes to rotation for SY 2019-2020: Technology will have more focus on digital media and storytelling. Math will incorporate more enrichment activities and games. Guidance starting a national program called "CHOOSE LOVE" a free program. -Socio-emotional (3rd grade) program called "ROOTS OF EMPATHY" a 27 week course that has students interact with an infant to teach and nurture empathy amongst students. Babies will be between (2-4 months young). Looking for more babies/parents to volunteer for the program.
